

MALLINCAM & CELESTRON IMAGE CENTERING

1. Initialize the 24" scope and Mallincam. Turn on the small dome monitor.
2. Using an eyepiece equipped with a crosshair, centre up a star in the 24" scope.
3. Enable the Mallincam crosshair – Advanced tab, Crosshairs or CrossBox.
4. Loosen ½" bolt 'A' on the piggybacked Celestron telescope base plate located on the top of the 24" telescope mirror box.
5. Adjust the base plate left or right to centre the image horizontally on the small dome monitor. **Do not strike the base as you may cause collimation problems!**
6. Adjust 9/16" bolts 'B' and 'C' equally to adjust the image vertically.
7. Retighten ½" bolt 'A' when adjustments are completed.
